Having grown up during the civil rights era, Ms. Gilliam has witnessed first-hand the invaluable role of strong families (mothers and fathers) as an essential component in the character development and civic maturation of our youth, as a building block for strong neighborhoods and schools, and as the chief instrument for combating a growing social ambivalence to crime and social irresponsibility. She strives to provide history, purpose and hope.
